SCRIPTURE TEXT: EXODUS 2: 1-10

LESSON OUTLINE

EXODUS 2:2: Moses was a goodly child.

Acts 7:20 Stephen said he was exceeding fair: Fair to God

Hebrews 11:23 says he was a proper child. Proper was taken from the same word as fair in Acts 7:20

Development: A process that creates growth, progress, or positive change. An advanced state or form.

Exodus 2:10: And the child grew: speaking of Moses physically.

We also need to grow spiritually.

2nd Peter 2:1-3. God's word produces growth.

2nd Peter 3:18, We are to grow in grace.

2nd Thessalonians 1:3. Growing in faith and abounding in love.

2nd Corinthians 8:7. Abounding in faith, utterance, knowledge, diligence, love, and grace.

Colossians 1: 3-10. Filled with the knowledge of God's will. Having wisdom and spiritual understanding.

1st Corinthians 15:58. Steadfast, unmoveable, abounding in the work of the Lord.

2nd Peter 1:5-9: Adding to your faith; virtue, knowledge, temperance; patience; godliness, kindness, charity(love).

Genesis 15:13-14. God forewarns Abram of Israel's coming captivity in Egypt.

Exodus 2. Moses born at a time when things had become very difficult in Egypt for the children of Israel.

Acts 7:22-24. Moses lived his first 40 years in Egypt.

Acts 7:30. He lived the next 40 years in the desert.

Exodus 3:1-6. God speaks to him from the burning bush.

Exodus 3:4 through 4:17, the following things are recorded:

God tells Moses He is aware of the situation in Egypt and He has come down to deliver them from it.

He tells Moses He is sending him to Egypt.

Moses questioned God and made excuses why he shouldn't go.

Exodus 3:6. At the burning bush Moses was afraid to look upon God.

Exodus 33:18. Moses asked God to show him His glory.

Exodus 4:1. At the burning bush, they wont believe you appeared unto me.

Exodus 14:13. At the Red Sea. Fear ye not, stand still, and see the salvation of the Lord.

Deuteronomy 34:10-12. Not another prophet like Moses.

Numbers 20: 9-13. Moses disobedience by striking the rock and the punishment he received.
